



MY RAYO USER GUIDE

CONNECTING RAYO

Your Rayo will show up on the **SEARCH** screen of the app when found. Select your Rayo taillight to connect to it. When successfully connected, the blue LED on Rayo will light up and the app will show the **MAIN** screen.

- * Do not use your smartphone's system interface to connect to Rayo.
- * You must turn on Rayo at least once after purchase in order to connect to it.
- * You can connect to Rayo regardless of whether it is turned on or off.

CONFIGURATION

Through the **CONFIGURATION** menu, you can customize the behavior and blinking pattern of each mode. In the **CONFIGURATION** screen, select the mode you wish to configure using the tabs on Android or the drop-down menu on iOS. Your Rayo taillight will automatically turn on and change to the selected mode.

BRAKE LIGHT

When enabled, Rayo will emit a brake signal when slowing down. You can set the **SENSITIVITY** of the brake signal to low, mid, or high.

SYNCHRONIZE PATTERN

When enabled, Rayo will synchronize its blinking pattern with nearby Rayos that also have **SYNCHRONIZATION** enabled. In order for synchronization to have any effect, the blinking patterns of all Rayos should be set the same.

PERSONALIZATION

Enabling **PERSONALIZATION** makes your Rayo taillight seen by only your smartphone. Rayo taillights that have personalization enabled will be listed as **PERSONALIZED DEVICES** on Android or shown under **PAIRED DEVICES** on iOS.
